Adventure for both old and young - Pedaling a trolley

To pedal a trolley on a shut-down railway is an adventure for the whole family, both old and young.

Come and pedal on Sweden's longest closed-down railway, 93 km, from Morjärv to Haparanda. The starting point is in Vitvattnet in the Municipality of Kalix. There you can choose towards which direction you prefer to go, the Station is located 30 km from Morjärv, 63 km from Haparanda.

The trolley is easy to conduct and with the dunk from the rails you feel the wings of history when you pass the old station buildings. You travel in your own pace and stop by, enjoying coffee- time or lunch. The midnight sun is shining, and the late hour makes the experience even more impressive.

Experience nature at close range, smell the forest and land. Over bridges, past lakes and open fields where cows graze. During the summer the reindeers are strolling freely around, perhaps your first meeting will take place on this journey. A hare might jump quickly over the rails.



Take a break from everyday pulse

Come and stay in a timbered cottage on the mountain, giving room to 4 persons.

Here you have self-catering and can choose to eat outdoor or inside. There is a barbecue on the patio and your afternoon coffee is on the "Liars Bench" where you have a wonderful view over the lake. The midnight sun warms a long time on the patio and probably you don't want to go and fold.

Pick some berries around the cottage, take a walk in the woods or sit on the pier and enjoy the tranquillity. Try fishing or maybe go out rowing the boat and cast a while after the perch. Available activities are boat, fishing and cycling.

You have access to a separate wood-fired sauna with dressing room. Firewood and towel are included in the price. To sit in the contiguous heat will purify both your body and spirit. Afterwards, you will feel both relaxed and "cosily tired".
